



The vast majority of students either agreed or strongly agreed they liked having council (94.81%).










47 students stated that because of council, they now feel more comfortable speaking in front of others.








The vast majority of students agreed or strongly agreed that the topics they spoke about in council were meaningful and interesting to them.




73 students, the vast majority, stated that the topics discussed in council were meaningful and interesting students were unsure.




28 students stated they would consider using council with their friends and/or family.
