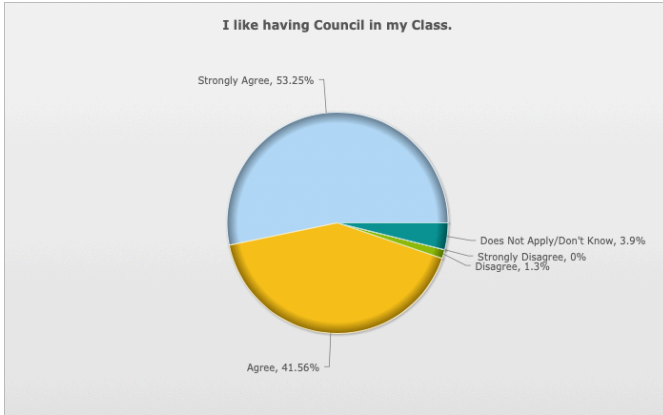


Comparison of Council Feedback for Cohorts from 2019/20 and 2020/21

2019/20 (77 students total)

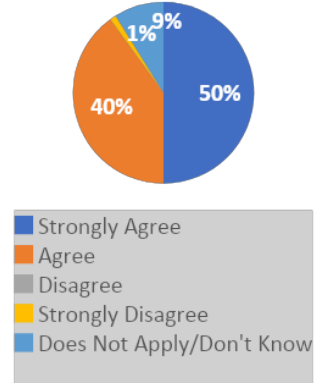
The vast majority of students either agreed or strongly agreed they liked having council (94.81%).



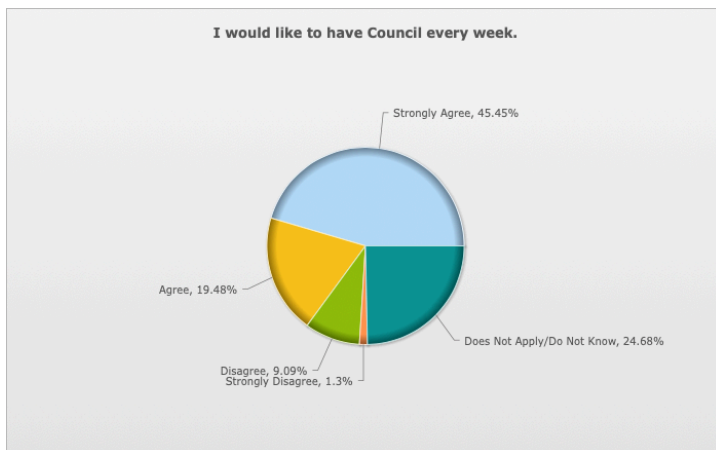
2020/21 (100 students total)

I Like having Council in my Class

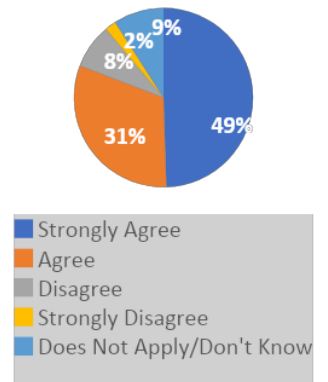


The majority of students either agreed or strongly agreed that they would like to have council every week (64.93%).



80 students stated that they would like to have council every week.

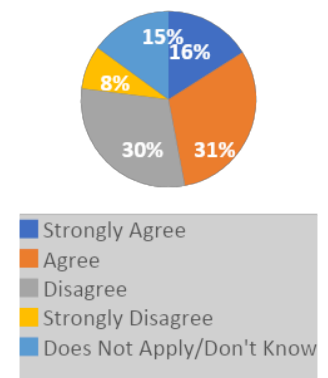
I would like to have Council Every week

47 students stated that, because of council, they feel more comfortable speaking in front of others, though 38 d with the statement.

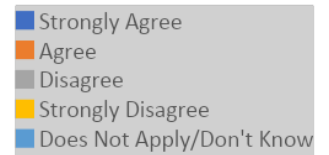
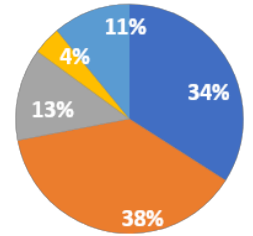
I feel more comfortable speaking in front of others

72 students stated that, because of council they now listen more openly to others.

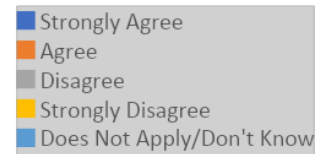
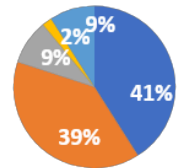
I listen more openly to others

80 students stated that, because of council, they now have a better understanding of the people in their class

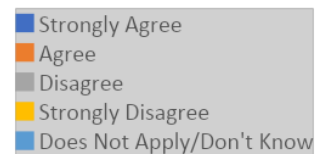
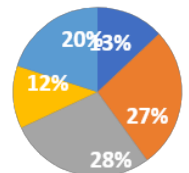
I now have a better understanding of people in my class



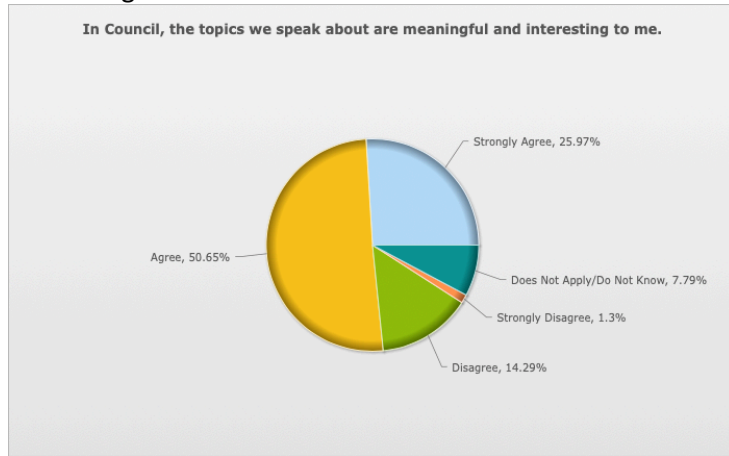
36 students stated that because of council, they now have a better understanding of themselves.

Because of Council, I have a better understanding of myself

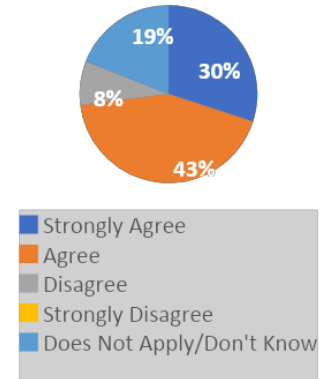


The vast majority of students agreed or strongly agreed that the topics they spoke about in council were meaningful and interesting to them.



73 students, the vast majority, stated that the topics discussed in council were meaningful and interesting and students were unsure.

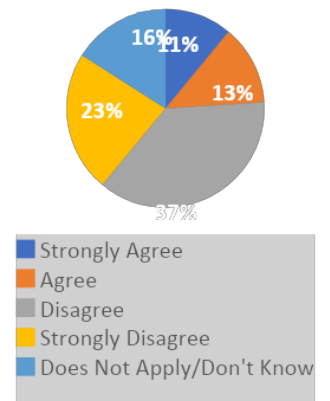
The topics discussed were Meaningful and Interesting to me



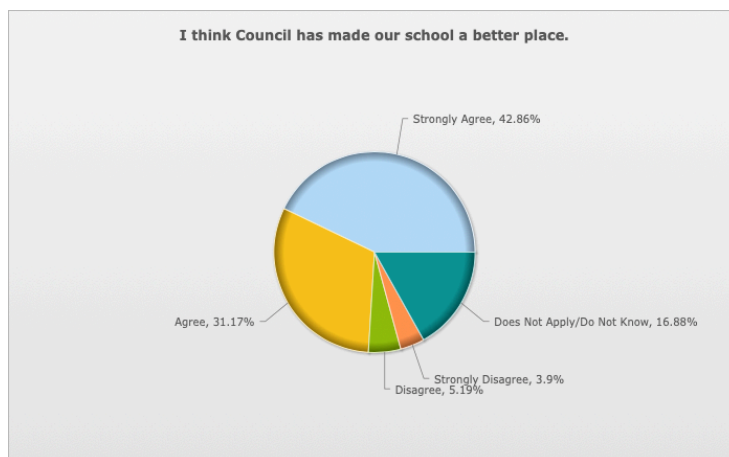
28 students stated they would consider using council with their friends and/or family.

I would consider using council with my friends and family

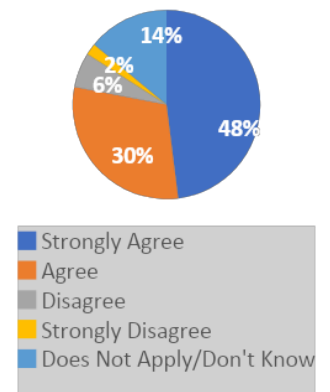


The vast majority of students agreed or strongly agreed that council made their school a better place (74.03%).
